




Poverty Population ("000)







## Child Development Fund

### Background:

In April 2008, the SAR Government set aside \$300 million to set up a "Child Development Fund" pilot scheme to build a "Child Led-Asset Based" development model. It is to help children and youth aged 10-16 to enhancing on their development stage. It also promote the long-term development of children in poor communities, final to reduce the intergenerational poverty.







#### **Program Vision**

- •Life is full of possibilities
- Let young people growing up in poor families
- •Despite the challenges and limitations, still able to look at the clear sky
- •The world is so big, take optimism
- Actively enjoy life
- Carry out your own life

#### **Program Content**

The fund consists of three main elements:

- Personal Development Plan
- Mentorship (one to one)
- Target Savings (3 years)



Goal: Enhance children's ability to manage resources and plan for the future

- \* Establish and implement a personal development plan;
- \* Sharing life experience
- \* Assist children in augmenting their vision
- \* Building a social network
- \* Develop good attitudes and positive thinking

Are you willing to participate?

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. (Proverbs 22:6)

### Participate in Mentorship Program

#### **Qualification:**

- Aspiring to serve poor children and adolescents
- Persons 21 years of age or older
- Recommended by organization / church / company
- Receive 8 hours of pilot training, pass interviews and assessments
   (Contents include: understanding the role of mentor, the need for youth to grow up, how to build relationships with youth, etc.)

#### **Participation:**

- Be a mentor is to support the growth of poor children
- Assisting children to achieve long-term and short-term goals
- \$200@month, support the savings plan for children
- Monthly regularly meet, support, and caring for children (about 3 hours @ month)
- Regular participation in mentor training
- Planned for 3 years

Step 1: Participate in the "Child Development Fund" (CDF) program and register as a mentor

Step 2: Referral to the "CDF" operating organization, or screening

Step 3: Receive Mentorship training activities (8 hours), 15 people can group themselves

Step 4: Operating Organization assist in matching suitable low-income families

Step 5: At least 3 hours caring per month

Step 6: Participate in organizing meetings and training events every 3 months


