The social poverty situation has not improved. According to the Commission on Poverty, there are 226,000 people in Hong Kong living in subdivided housing. One in two elders and one in four children are below the poverty line. The four dimensions of poverty include: economic poverty, spiritual poverty, relationship poverty, and motivation poverty.
